Please be advised that John McIntosh, Q.C., has now referred this matter to the Conduct Investigation Committee for their review and direction. A copy of Mr. McIntosh's decision is attached for your reference. Upon review of the file materials, the Committee can make one of the following decisions:

- (a) directing that no further action be taken, if it is of the opinion that the complaint does not constitute conduct unbecoming;
- (b) inviting the member to meet with a Conduct Review Committee under Rule 401;
- (c) referring the complaint to the Ethics Committee or the Professional Standards Committee;
- (d) directing the Chair of Discipline to appoint a Hearing Committee under 47(1) of the *Act*, to hear and determine a formal complaint.

If no further action is recommended, you will have a right of appeal to Complainants' Review Committee.

If a Conduct Review Committee is appointed, experienced members of the Law Society will review the lawyer's conduct in this matter. The lawyer will be asked to appear in person to the Committee to discuss the matter, conduct and how similar situations could be handled in the future.

If the matter is referred to the Chair of another Committee, either the Professional Standards Committee or Ethics Committee, we will advise you and provide further information at that time.

If a Hearing is recommended, you will be advised once we have reviewed the report from the Conduct Investigation Committee.
